NWF co-created a free, self-paced virtual Climate Education course for educators. The focus is on climate change and biodiversity/wildlife and includes the following topics of study: earth systems; climate vs. weather; phenology; extreme weather; biodiversity; soils; and oceans. The course opens today and will close in June. Upon completion of the course, educators will receive free lessons from Project WET (www.projectwet.org), Project WILD (<https://www.fishwildlife.org/projectwild>) and NWF resources that can be used to (virtually) celebrate Earth Day 50. Note: the course is in English but is open to all interested audiences.
